



Registered Nurse Preceptorship programme

This programme is offered to support the newly qualified or return to practice registered nurses to fulfil their professional role with confidence and meets the requirements identified by the Nursing and Midwifery Council. The preceptorship programme is supported for 12 months though may be completed in less time.

The Programme

The programme works through an understanding of the individual learning needs of the nurse and identifies targets and support systems that are needed to meet those targets. Individual support is delivered through experienced RN mentors and a buddying system to provide maximum support for professional development.

In addition to this programme the Lane Fox REMEO Centre induction package will run in parallel with the preceptorship to provide support for learning the specialist skills required for working in the centre.

Throughout the preceptorship period the preceptee will work as an RN alongside his/her colleagues, as part of the team with the support needed to feel confident in the daily activities in the centre.
